**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST DEPTFORD CONCURRING WITH THE
NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RECOMMENDATION
ESTABLISHING NO PASSING ZONES**

WHEREAS, New Jersey Department of Transportation has requested that an investigation be conducted to determine the need for "No Passing Zones"; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation has completed an investigation and has recommended that a "No Passing Zone" be established; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation requires a Resolution of support in order to promulgate the required Traffic Regulation Order establishing the "No Passing Zones" pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39;4-8.4c from the Township Committee of West Deptford Township; and

WHEREAS, the West Deptford Township Committee has reviewed the request and recommends the establishment of the "No Passing Zones" along Crown Point Road, Access road East and West (vicinity of Route I-295) which is under State jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of West Deptford, County of Gloucester, and State of New Jersey that the Mayor and Committee concur with the New Jersey Department of Transportation's recommendation(s) to establish "No Passing Zones" along Crown Point Road, Access road East and West (vicinity of Route I-295) which is under State jurisdiction as follows:


- a. The existing centerline markings along Crown Point Road access road East and West (vicinity of I-295) will remain a No Passing Zone.
- b. The Township Committee of the Township of West Deptford Township, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey concurs that any approved No Passing Zones in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution be rescinded upon

approval of the Traffic Regulation Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect upon approval of the Commissioner of Transportation as provided by law.



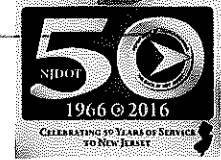

Dear Ms.Leso:

This is in reference to an investigation by the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) to inventory the existing centerline markings along Crown Point Rd. Access Rd. East & West(vicinity of I-295) under State Jurisdiction in the Township of West Deptford, County of Gloucester.

Staff of the Bureau of Traffic Engineering (BTE) has completed an investigation. Based on this investigation, the existing centerline markings are in compliance with current design standards. Therefore, the existing centerline markings along Crown Point Rd. Access Rd. East & West (vicinity of I-295) will remain a No Passing Zone.

Although the centerline markings will not change, NJDOT will still need to update our records. In order to do so, these updates must be legally established as "No Passing Zones" requiring a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO). An initial step in the TRO process is to receive a Resolution of Support (Concurrence) from the municipal governing body. The New Jersey Department of Transportation now requests that the Resolution of Concurrence be submitted within 90 days. Enclosed is a sample Resolution of Concurrence for your use.

Once this office is in receipt of the certified adopted Resolution of Concurrence from the West Deptford Township governing body, a Traffic Regulation Order will be promulgated.
