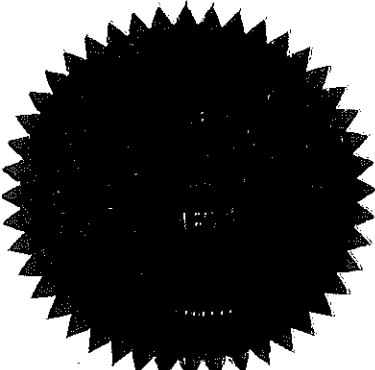
WHEREAS, the residents and businesses of West Deptford Township are encouraged to "Light It Up Blue" to show support for those with Autism.
