**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST DEPTFORD
AUTHORIZING A PERMIT FOR A FIREWORKS DISPLAY FOR THE CITY OF WOODBURY**

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury will again sponsor the 2018 public display of fireworks to be held at the Woodbury High School and the Frances Avenue Complex in the Township of West Deptford; and

WHEREAS, City of Woodbury has requested said permit to continue the tradition of July 4th Firework display and has solicited proposals and awarded to a licensed contractor as per attached resolution and contract; and

WHEREAS, such display will be supervised by competent and experienced person in compliance with N.J.S.A. 21:3-4 of the State of New Jersey, and will not be a detriment to the community, but to the contrary will offer substitute for the heretofore indiscriminate and unlawful use of fireworks on the part of the individuals; and

WHEREAS, the location where such a display will be held is within the jurisdiction of West Deptford Township and is therefore under the jurisdiction of West Deptford Township Fire Official, John Austin; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the West Deptford Township Committee as follows:

1. Pursuant to the authority granted under N.J.S.A. 21:3-1, N.J.S.A. 21:3-3 and N.J.S.A. 21:3-4 of the State of New Jersey, the Fire Official of West Deptford Township be and is hereby authorized to make, execute and deliver a good and sufficient license of permit to City of Woodbury/ Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks, authorizing the public display of fireworks during the evening of Saturday, June 30, 2018 at approximately 9:00 p.m., eastern daylight time, under the supervision of **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks, PO Box 149, New Castle, PA 16103**, a fully qualified pyrotechnical firm, the company named in the application heretofore. Said fireworks are to be delivered on Saturday, June 30, 2018 and will remain on the truck at the Woodbury High School and/or Frances Avenue Complex. Said license shall be without force and effect until such time as the fireworks display company, **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks** shall file with the Fire Official proof of insurance coverage naming the Township of West Deptford as an additional insured, including a statutory bond, which are satisfactory to the Solicitor, which would indemnify any person who may receive or sustain injury to his or her person or property by reason of any discharge of the fireworks in question and a Hold Harmless Agreement to the benefit of the Township of West Deptford, in a form satisfactory to the Solicitor. All operations incidental to such display shall be subject to the approval of the Chief of Police, Samuel DiSimone and John Austin, Fire Official of the Township of West Deptford as required by law; and
2. If the rain date that is established is beyond the ninety-six (96) hour limit, the fireworks will be removed from the storage area in the Township and returned to the site twenty-four (24) hours prior to a new date of fireworks display. The storage area will be the middle of the Frances Avenue Fields; and

ADOPTED at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of West Deptford, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, on May 16, 2018.

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY
AUTHORIZING A PERMIT FOR FIREWORKS DISPLAY AND AUTHORIZING THE
MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR THE FOURTH OF JULY PUBLIC
FIREWORKS DISPLAY**

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury will again sponsor this year's public display of fireworks to be held at the Woodbury High School and the Frances Avenue Complex on the evening of Saturday, June 30, 2018, with the rain date to be Sunday, July 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury is desirous of continuing the tradition of a Fourth of July public fireworks display by sponsoring said event; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury wishes to engage **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks** for the June 30, 2018 fireworks display in the amount of \$11,000; and

WHEREAS, such display will be supervised by competent and experienced persons in compliance with N.J.S.A. 21:3-4 of the State of New Jersey, and will not be a detriment to the community, but to the contrary will offer substitute for the heretofore indiscriminate and unlawful use of fireworks on the part of the individuals; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Woodbury, the Mayor concurring, as follows:

1. Pursuant to the authority granted under N.J.S.A. 21:3-1, N.J.S.A. 21:3-3 and N.J.S.A. 21:3-4 of the State of New Jersey, the City Clerk and/or Administrator of the City of Woodbury be and hereby authorized to make, execute and deliver a good and sufficient license of permit to the City of Woodbury, authorizing the public display of fireworks at the Woodbury High School property and/or Frances Avenue Complex during the evening of Saturday, June 30, 2018 at approximately 9:00 p.m., eastern daylight time, under the supervision of **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks, PO Box 149, New Castle PA 16103**, a fully qualified pyrotechnical firm, the company named in the application heretofore submitted to the Fire Marshal. Said fireworks are to be delivered on Saturday, June 30, 2018 and will remain on the truck at the Woodbury High School and/or Frances Avenue Complex until set up. Said license shall be without force and effect until such time as the fireworks display company, **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks**, shall file with the Fire Marshal insurance coverage naming the City of Woodbury, the Township of West Deptford, and the Woodbury School District as additional insureds, including a statutory bond, which are satisfactory to the Solicitor, which would indemnify any person who may receive or sustain injury to his or her person or property by reason of any discharge of the fireworks in question and a Hold Harmless Agreement to the benefit of the City of Woodbury, in a form satisfactory to the Solicitor. All operations incidental to such display shall be subject to the approval of the Chief of Police and Fire Department of the City of Woodbury as required by law; and


2. If the rain date that is established is beyond the ninety-six (96) hour limit, the fireworks will be removed from the storage area in the City and returned to the site twenty-four (24) hours prior to a new date of fireworks display. The storage area will be the middle of the Frances Avenue Fields; and

3. The Mayor, Jessica Floyd, is hereby authorized to execute a contract for the fireworks display between the City of Woodbury and the fireworks provider, **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks**.

4. Any city of Woodbury permit fees are hereby waived.


