RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST DEPTFORD AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL BY RECYCLING OF SIXTY-TWO (62) USED AVAYA SYSTEM PHONES AND ONE (1) OPERATOR PHONE NO LONGER NEEDED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST DEPTFORD

WHEREAS, the Township of West Deptford (hereinafter referred to as "Township") owns sixty-two (62) used Avaya System phones and one (1) operator phone previously used at the Riverwinds Community Center; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the sixty-two (62) used phones and one (1) operator phone are no longer operable and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that due to the condition of the phones, the Township is not in a position to offer the used phones for sale; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that it is in its best interest of the Township to dispose of the sixty-two (62) used phones and one (1) operator phone by recycling same.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of West Deptford, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, that the Township does hereby authorize the recycling of the sixty-two (62) used Avaya System phones and one (1) operator phone as they are no longer operable and of no value.
